The Universal Spirituality (Human Values) Program is organised and run by Sathya Sai Centre of Hurstville on every 1st Thursday of the month for all Sai Centre/Group members and general public, with emphasis on 'Human Values'.

The program is to awaken in all beings the awareness of our common existence in the diversity of our life-styles -

- For the unity of all
- For the peace of our minds
- For the harmony and progress of all people amidst other creations

Program

- **Meditation on Cosmic Sound:** *the preamble sound that emanated at the time of creation of the universe, which occupied the whole Space and in all creations.*
- **Earth Anthem:** *A pleading to Divinity for the peace, progress, environmental cleanliness and freedom from violence for all creations on our earth.*
- **Devotional/Human Values singing:** *Singing the human values and Glory of God in His meriads of names in any language.*
- **Universal prayer:** *A prayer for enlightenment to the creator of the universe - presented in Sanskrit and English versions with no restrictions to any other language.*
- **Interactive Human Values Presentation: "Religion of Love" - by: Ravi Shankar**
- **Universal prayer/singing for world peace:** *'May the love we're sharing spread its wings...'* combined with the Sanskrit verse - 'Samasta loka sukhino bhawantu...'
- **THE END**
- **Light Refreshments:** *Sweets, cakes, fruits, drinks (Participants may pick up 'vibhuti' packs from the refreshment table)*

More about this program:

- The program is about the understanding and practice of Human Values as the foundation of all faiths.
- This common foundation is also the source of unity in the diversity of human existence.
- The program excludes the practice of religious faiths apart from the universal spiritual practices, which are identified by the organising team of Sai devotees of Sathya Sai Centre of Hurstville.
- The program is open to all Sai devotees irrespective of their membership to Sai centres/groups. It is also open to the general public irrespective of their religious faiths.
- The participants are expected to come with open mind only to concentrate on human values based items for study and practice.
- It is not for the study of any religion, rituals and cultures.
- Religious faith quotations may be used to understand the human values as the fundamentals of all faiths.
- The whole program is based on the universal teachings of Sathya Sai Baba whose small identity is placed at the Shrine as a mark of respect.
- The participants must not expect the display of their faith symbols of any kind apart from universally accepted symbol such as a candlelight.
- The participants are also expected to participate in a respectful, simple and decent dress.
- A good personal conduct in the program is paramount requisite.
- After the conclusion of the program, participant's personal comments is welcome and may place it in the suggestion box. We value your comments which may bring better adjustment to the program.
