Global Akhanda Bhajan Continuous Devotional Singing

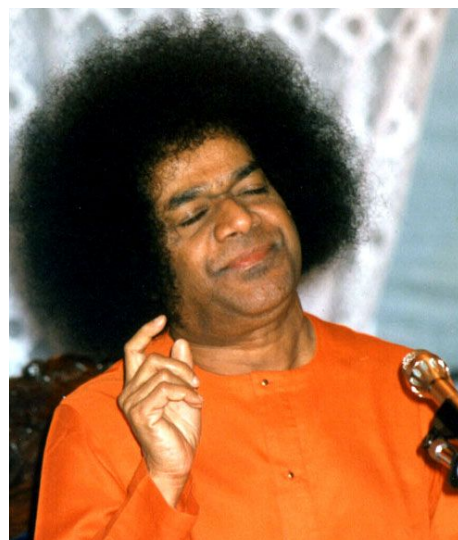

It is sung for one's own joy, one's own satisfaction, one's own delight. Kirtan of this supreme type alone, deserves the name samkirtan."
